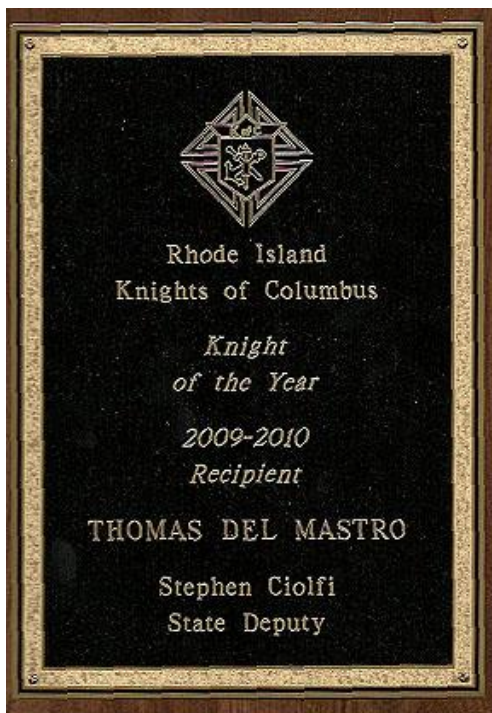
Yard Sale
